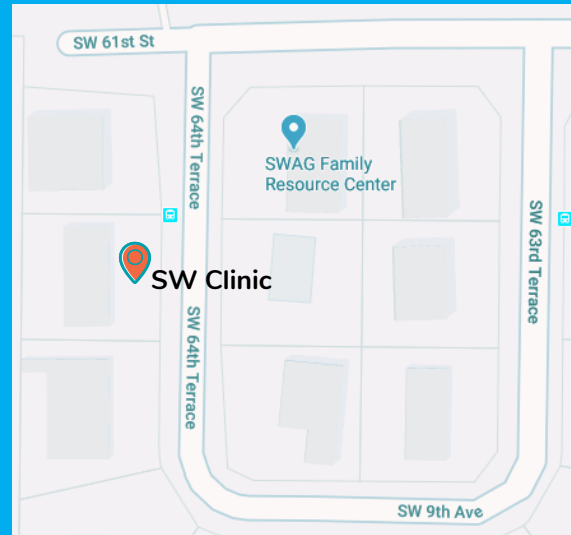

FINANCIAL ELIGIBILITY

To receive certain services, financial screening is required. In order to determine the appropriate fee scale you will need to provide documentation like food stamp letter, W2, proof of student loan/financial aid, etc. Clients who elect to waive their income eligibility determination will be responsible for the full cost of the service provided. Applications for temporary Medicaid for pregnant women (PEPW) and Family Planning Waiver Medicaid are available for clients who meet eligibility requirements.

PEDIATRIC DENTAL

The Pediatric Dental Program promises to help your child achieve excellent oral health in an atmosphere of trust and mutual respect. Our program offers full dental services to children ages 0-20. We provide the following services: dental exams, cleanings, oral hygiene education, fluoride treatment, sealants, x-rays, fillings, extractions, and referrals for other dental needs not provided by our office.

FAMILY PLANNING

This Family Planning Program strives to reduce the number of unintended pregnancies and sexually transmitted diseases. The Family Planning Team provides comprehensive education, clinical services, and resources for women, men, and teens. Services include pap smears, breast exams, STD/HIV testing, different methods of birth control, education, pregnancy testing, and sterilization.

WIC

WIC is a federally funded nutrition program for Women, Infants, and Children. WIC provides the following at no cost: healthy foods, nutrition education and counseling, breastfeeding support, and referrals for health care and community services.
